Typically, from the time you turn your application in, most applicants complete the process in about a month. We perform a background check during that time, applicants must attend at least 2 drills. Once you have attended 2 drills, we will schedule a interview for membership.

Training is typically held on Wednesday nights starting at 1800hrs at Station 32 (6131 Highway 211, Newport, WA. 99156
